Help and funds are available from the larger energy suppliers.

You could be eligible if:

- Your property has a low EPC rating and requires energy efficiency upgrades
- You own your home or have permission from the landlord, including a social landlord in some cases.

There are 2 schemes:

Energy Company Obligation (ECO) 4

- A 'whole house' approach, providing loft and wall insulation and air source heat pumps as needed.
- To be eligible, you must receive a qualifying benefit.

Great British Insulation Scheme (GBIS)

- One type of insulation only, typically loft or cavity wall
- Low-income group: must receive a qualifying benefit
- General group: Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating D-G, and Council Tax Band A-D.

ECO4 and GBIS are not grant schemes, so companies provide different levels of financial support.
